## G24 welcomes new global corporate tax, expects 'meaningful' revenues for developing states

Washington, Oct 11 (UNI/Sputnik) The Group of 24 (G24) on Monday supported the new global corporate tax, citing possible benefits for the emerging and developing economies (EMDEs). The Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) last Friday finalized the international tax deal, which guarantees that multinational enterprises will be subject to a minimum 15% tax.

"We welcome the introduction of a global minimum corporate tax to address harmful tax competition and new rules to allocate a portion of taxable profits of multinationals to market countries. We expect that the multilateral solution under the proposed two-pillar approach will yield meaningful revenues for EMDEs, which is an important step toward a fairer and more stable international corporate tax system," the G24 said in a statement.


